**ORDER APPOINTING TEMPORARY SPECIAL MASTER**

This cause came on to be heard upon the Plaintiff's Petition for Appointment of a Special Master and, upon consideration thereof, it is hereby

**ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED**

1. That Richard Land, of Providence, Rhode Island be and hereby is appointed Temporary Special Master (the "Special Master") of the Defendant.
2. That said Special Master shall, no later than five (5) days from the date hereof, file a bond in the amount of \$10,000, with any surety company authorized to do business in the State of Rhode Island as surety thereon, conditioned that the Special Master will well and truly perform the duties of said office and duly account for all monies and property which may come into the Special Master's hands and abide by and perform all things which the Special Master will be directed to do by this Court.
3. That said Special Master is authorized to take possession and charge of all of the estate, assets, effects, property and business of the Defendant, to collect all of the debts and property belonging to it and to preserve the same until further Order of this Court.
4. That said Special Master is authorized, until further Order of this Court, in the Special Master's discretion and as said Special Master deems appropriate and advisable, to conduct the business of said Defendant, to borrow money from time to time subject to Court approval after notice and a hearing, to purchase, for cash or upon credit, merchandise, materials and other property, to engage appraisers and/or employees and assistants, clerical or otherwise, and subject to Paragraph 8, below, to pay all such individuals and entities in the usual course of business, and to do and perform or cause to be done and performed all other acts and things as are appropriate in the premises.

5. That, pursuant to and in compliance with Rhode Island Supreme Court Executive Order No. 2000-2, this Court finds that the designation of the aforescribed person for appointment as Special Master herein is warranted and required because of the Special Master's specialized expertise and experience in operating businesses under a Special Master and in administrating non-routine issues under a Special Master which involve unusual or complex legal, financial, or business issues.


6. That the commencement, prosecution, or continuance of the prosecution, of any action, suit, arbitration proceeding, hearing, or any foreclosure, reclamation or repossession proceeding, both judicial and non-judicial, or any other proceeding, in law, or in equity or under any statute, or otherwise, against said Defendant or any of its property, in any Court, agency, tribunal, or elsewhere, or before any arbitrator, or otherwise by any creditor, stockholder, corporation, partnership or any other person, or the levy of any attachment, execution or other process upon or against any property of said Defendant, or the taking or attempting to take into possession any property in the possession of the Defendant or of which the Defendant has the right to possession, or the interference with the Special Master's taking possession of or retaining possession of any such property, or the cancellation at any time during the oversight of a Special Master proceeding herein of any insurance policy, lease or other contract with Defendant, by any of such parties as aforesaid, other than the Special Master designated as aforesaid, or the termination of telephone, electric, gas or other utility service to Defendant, by any public utility, without obtaining prior approval thereof from this Honorable Court, in which connection said Special Master shall be entitled to prior notice and an opportunity to be heard, are hereby restrained and enjoined until further Order of this Court.

7. That hearing regarding the status of the Special Mastership and procedures relating thereto shall be held on Wednesday, October 17, 2012 at 2:00 p.m. in Courtroom 2, McGrath Judicial Complex, 4800 Tower Hill Road, Wakefield, Rhode Island, at which time and place interested parties may be heard.



That any firefighters and other of Defendant's employees who work for the Special Master without being paid their compensation for such work when due shall be entitled to an allowed administrative claim herein for such compensation, which shall be paid by the Special Master as soon as reasonably practical.
